LITERACY GRANT EVALUATION

INSTRUCTIONS

Please read instructions <u>carefully</u> before beginning the evaluation process.

A. <u>Because this is an evidence-based grant, you will be required to prove the success of your project/initiative with data and examples and describe how you measured that success.</u> The purpose of the Grant Evaluation is to provide evidence, i.e. survey data/anecdotal evidence/eyewitness accounts, which explain how the success of the project/initiative was understood and/or measured.

B. The GRANT EVALUATION is to be completed at the conclusion of your project/initiative. Applicants must complete the Grant Evaluation <u>8 months from notification of the award</u>.

C. The <u>final written evaluation narrative</u> should be 3-5 pages and no less than 10 point font. <u>If</u> the evaluation is not complete <u>and acceptable to the grantor</u>, and completed by the established <u>deadline</u>, the recipient will lose funding</u>. Four to six photos must accompany the evaluation and be sent electronically also.

D. The GRANT EVALUATION is a narrative that assesses and evaluates and the intention and accomplishments of the project/initiative. The format provided on the LLF Michigan website must be used by all applicants to evaluate their project/initiative.
